

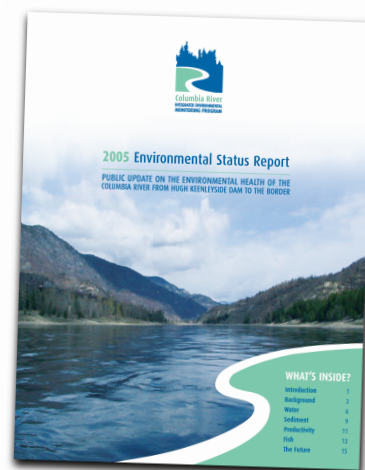
You are invited...
